1. Brief Introduction of MPC Autonomous College

Christened after the Late Maharaja Purna Chandra Bhanja Deo, the enlightened ruler of the erstwhile Princely state of Mayurbhanj, the College has been successfully catering to the need of higher education of the people, not only of Odisha but also of its adjoining states since its inception in July 1948. Over the years the institution has grown from strength to strength and from glory to glory by adding fresh feathers to its cap of success. With the conferment of Autonomous status upon the College by the UGC and Govt. of Odisha in 2000-2001 and accreditation by NAAC, the College has added two more shining feathers to its cap of success.

2. Department of ITEP

The Integrated B.Ed. department has been operationalized in MPC Autonomous College, Baripada from academic session 2016-17 with four years BA B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. courses in self-financing mode having 50 seats in each stream. From the academic session 2023-24, the department has started offering Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) with one unit each B.A B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. as per NCTE guidelines followed by NEP-2020.

3. Courses

The College provides 4-Years Integrated B.A. B.Ed. & B.Sc. B.Ed. (ITEP) course for the academic session 2025-26.

4. Eligibility for admission

As per NCTE Guide Line-2019(Govt. of India Gazette No.-118, April 02, 2019),

- The applicants must have passed +2 Arts/Science or Equivalent Examinations securing at least 50% of marks in aggregate without extra optional.
- The applicant must have appeared the National Common Entrance Test (NCET – 2025) as mentioned in the prospectus 2025-26.
- **For admission in B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM)**
 - a) Candidate must have appeared the NCET 2025 exam in **Physics or Chemistry or Mathematics** as their domain subjects and
 - b) Candidate must have passed class XII in Science stream having **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** as the combination of subjects.
- **For admission in B.Sc. B.Ed. (CBZ)**
 - a) Candidate must have appeared the NCET 2025 exam in **Biology / Biological Studies / Biotechnology / Bio-chemistry** as their domain subject and
 - b) Candidate must have passed class XII in science stream with Biology as one of the subject.
- **For admission in B.A. B.Ed.**
 - a) Candidate must have passed class XII in any stream and
 - b) Candidate must have appeared the NCET 2025 exam.

5. Selection Procedure

The merit list for selection into **B.A.B.Ed.** and **B.Sc. B.Ed.** will be made on the basis of the weighted score (WS) which will be calculated as follows:-

$$\text{WS} = [\text{Percentile in Domain Subject 1} + \text{Percentile in Domain Subject 2} + \text{Percentile in Domain Subject 3} + \text{Percentile in General Test} + 0.8 * \{\text{Percentile in Language 1} + \text{Percentile in Language 2} + \text{Percentile in Teaching Aptitude}\}]$$

- In case of tie under selection criteria admission to Integrated B.A. B. Ed and B.Sc. B.Ed preference will be given to the applicant having higher percentile secured in Teaching Aptitude in NCET 2025. If percentile in Teaching Aptitude are tied, percentile secured in General Test in NCET 2025 will be taken into consideration. If the tie continues then the student with the higher age shall be considered.
- Selection of Major/Minor Subject will be made through open counselling after completion of admission process.

6. How to apply

- A candidate should read the Prospectus 2025-26 available in the college website thoroughly and ensure about the norms of admission before applying and paying of application fee.
- A candidate has to download the Application Form available in the college website www.mpcautocollege.org.in
- A candidate should make a Bank Draft of Rs 300/- in favour of **The Principal, M.P.C. Autonomous College, Takatpur, Baripada**, Payable at **Baripada**.
- A candidate has to send the filled in Application Form along with all supporting documents and the **Original Bank Draft** in the following address by **Speed Post only (no application shall be received in the college by hand)**.

Note :

- Candidates willing to apply for all three programs like B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM), B.Sc. B.Ed. (CBZ), and B.A. B.Ed. must submit separate application forms for each program along with separate bank drafts of Rs. 300/- each: one for the B.A. B.Ed. program, one for the B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM) program, and one for the B.Sc. B.Ed. (CBZ) program.
- The envelope containing the application form must be clearly superscribed with the respective program name as follows: '**Application Form for Admission into 4-Year Integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM) – ITEP 2025-26**', or '**Application Form for Admission into 4-Year Integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. (CBZ) – ITEP 2025-26**', or '**Application Form for Admission into 4-Year Integrated B.A. B.Ed. – ITEP 2025-26**'.

7. Reservation

Out of the total number of seats in MPC Autonomous College (B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed.) reservation as per rules of the Government of India will be applicable from time to time

- Candidates belonging to PwD and Visually Challenged-** Chief Medical Officer of Civil Hospital **(40% or more disability will only be considered).**
