## INSTRUCTION FOR IMPLEMENTATION ABOUT THE HEATWAVE MANAGEMENT IN HEIS

- 1.34
- 1. The timing of classes and examinations in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are to be conducted/rescheduled preferably during morning hours.
- Outdoor activities should be restricted or performed during afternoon sessions to minimize exposure to heatwave conditions.
- 3. Arrangement of drinking water and availability of ORS should be ensured in all HEIs.
- 4. Tube wells/ Pumps inside the HEIs must be repaired wherever necessary.
- 5. The provision for First Aid is to be kept in colleges and examination centres for use wherever required.
- 6. The Heads of the institution will sensitize the students regarding the heat wave precautionary measures.
- 7. A squad shall be constituted to check and enforce the implementation of the decision.
