# FOR ADMISSION TO FOUR-YEAR INTEGRATED B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. COURSE, (SELF-FINANCING)

#### 1. COURSES:

The College provides 4-Year Integrated B.A. B.Ed. & B.Sc. B.Ed. Course from the academic session 2019-20 under Self-Financing Mode.

# 2. SANCTIONED STRENGTH:

B.A. B.Ed. - 50 Seats

B.Sc. B.Ed. - 50 Seats (30 in PCM Group & 20 in CBZ Group)

# 3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

The applicants must have passed +2 Arts/Science or Equivalent Examinations (not earlier than 2017) securing at least 50% of marks in aggregate without extra optional.

In +2 Science PCM, 'M' stands for Mathematics or Statistics and in PCB, 'B' stands for Biology or Bio-technology.

# 4. PROCUREMENT OF APPLICATION FORM:

A candidate has to apply in the prescribed form which can be collected from college counter or down-loaded from the college website <a href="https://www.mpcautocollege.org.in">www.mpcautocollege.org.in</a>. A candidate, willing to apply for both the courses i.e. B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed., has to apply separately with requisite amount of application fee. A +2 Science candidate can also apply for B.A. B. Ed. Course. Further, Science candidate can avail both the options i.e., PCM & PCB by putting Tick  $\square$  mark in the appropriate box in the application form.

# 5. HOW TO APPLY:

Application form duly filled in should reach **The Principal M.P.C.** Autonomous College, Takhatpur, Baripada–757003 latest by the last date of receipt of forms by hand or by registered/ speed post / through courier along with required documents and the original Bank Draft of Rs.500/-(for each application form) in favour of *The principal, M.P.C. Autonomous College, Takhatpur, Baripada*, payable at Baripada. Postal delay is at candidate's risk. Application Form will be received at the College specified counter between 11.00 AM to 2.00 PM from 10-06-2019.

Note: If a candidate wants to apply for both B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM & CBZ) & B.A. B.Ed. then separate Draft of ₹ 500/- should be attached along with separate application form.

# 6. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM:

- Application Form duly filled in and signed by the Candidate and his / her Father/ Mother / Guardian at the places specified for the purpose.
- Original Bank Draft of Rs.500/- signed in full by the candidate on its back.
- One recent passport size photograph pasted in the appropriate box.
- Self-attested photo copies of certificates and mark sheets of both HSC or equivalent and +2 or equivalent examinations.
- Self-attested photo copies of certificates in support of reservation / weightage if claimed.
- Self-attested photo copy of Migration Certificate, if applicable.

(All Originals must be produced at the time of admission only.)

# 7. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The selection will be made on the basis of career marks taking together into account the % of marks secured in HSC or Equivalent and +2 Science/Arts or Equivalent Examinations without extra optional subjects, if any.

# 8. RESERVATION:

The seats will be reserved as per the existing State Government Rules for admission in higher education.

# 12. ADMISSION:

The selected / wait-listed candidates for admission are required to come personally to the college with required documents and fees for admission on the date and time specified in the Selection List. They are required to deposit the admission fee in cash in the collection counter and the course fee (Rs.35,000/-) in the shape of Bank Draft signed by the candidate on its back side to be drawn in favour of **The principal**, **M.P.C. Autonomous College**, **Takhatpur**, **Baripada**, payable at Baripada.

The Spot admission or admission of the candidates kept in the waiting list shall be made strictly on the basis of merit list subject to availability of seats. If selected, they will be required to deposit the admission fee in cash in the collection counter, but the Bank Draft towards the course fee (Rs.35,000/-) may be deposited on or before the last date of admission as mentioned at Para **14 ADMISSION SCHEDULE** failing which their claim for admission shall be forfeited.

# 15. SYLLABUS:

There shall be CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) pattern of syllabus. The detailed syllabus shall be made available later on.

# **16. EXAMINATION:**

There shall be Semester pattern of Examinations i.e. two in each academic session. The Examination Rules followed in the college shall be equally applicable.

# 17. HOSTEL ACCOMODATION:

There is no facility of hostel accommodation for the students admitted in the course.

# 18. INTERPRETATION OF RULES:
