



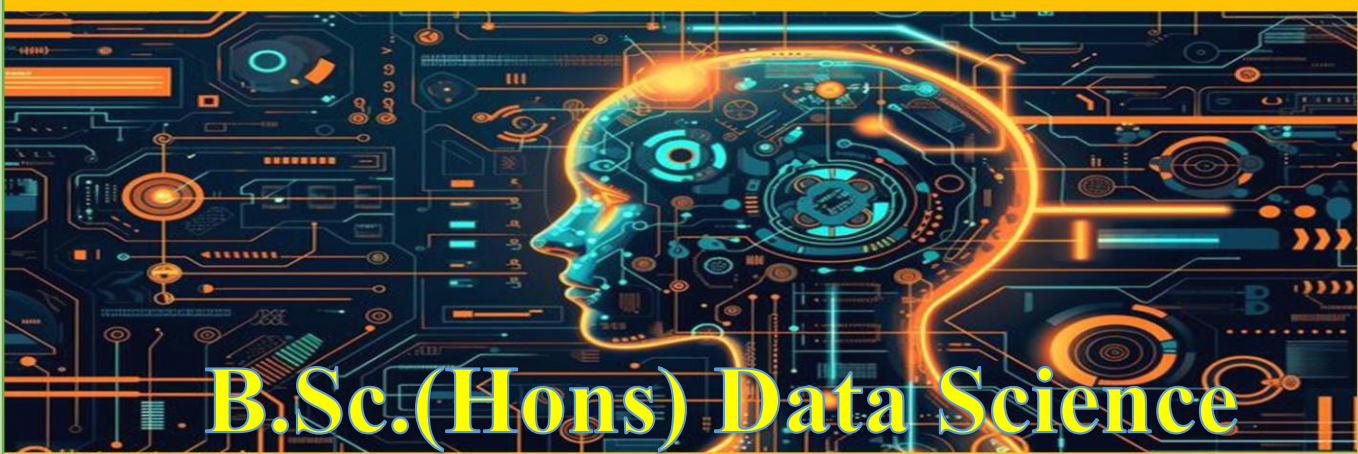

1. COLLEGE PROFILE:

Maharaja Purna Chandra Autonomous College, Takhatpur, Baripada is one of the Premier institutions of Higher Education in Odisha. Christened after the Late Maharaja Purna Chandra Bhanja Deo, the enlightened ruler of the erstwhile Princely state of Mayurbhanj, the College has been successfully catering to the need of higher education of the people, not only of Odisha but also of its adjoining states since its inception in July,1948. Over the years the institution has grown from strength to strength, glory to glory by adding fresh feathers to its cap of success. With the conferment of Autonomous status upon the College by the UGC and Govt. of Odisha in 2000-2001 and accreditation by NAAC with B+ grade, the College has added two more shining feathers to its cap of success. The College aims at providing quality higher education, building the character and conduct of the students and moulding the all-round development of their personality through various extension services and healthy practices.

2. COURSES OFFERED:

A) SELF-FINANCING U.G. COURSES:

- 1) Bachelor of Science in Information Technology and Management-[B.Sc. ITM]-3 years.
- 2) Bachelor of Science in Honours Data Science- [B.Sc. (Hons.) Data Science]-3 years.

3. FACULTY PROFILE:

The College has a team of highly qualified and experienced faculty members to impart quality education to the students. It also hires the services of guest faculties from renowned institutions to quench the intellectual thirst of the students.

4. HOSTELS:

The College has Three Boys hostels and two Girl's hostels (One exclusively for Tribal Girl's) to accommodate 180 nos. of Boy's and 172 nos. of Girl's students of both U.G. & P.G. Classes. Another 100 seated ST Boy's hostel, 400 Seated Girl's Hostel and 400 seated Boy's Hostel are now functional from the academic session 2020-21.

5. OTHER ACTIVITIES:

The College provides the students with ample scope to develop their personality and service to humanity through the NCC, NSS, YOUTH RED CROSS and ROVERS & RANGERS activities.

6. DRESS CODE:

The College has introduced the dress code for the students: Black trousers (Full pants) and steel grey full sleeve shirt for men and white salwar and dupatta, steel grey kameej for women. Students after admission are required to come to the college in the uniform, while attending Classes, examinations and for other college activities.

7. EXAMINATION:

There shall be two semester examinations in an academic session. The U.G. Courses is divided into 6 semesters.

8. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

8.1 3-Years U.G. Courses (Self-Financing)

B.Sc ITM: Applicants, who have passed the Higher Secondary (+2)/ Equivalent Exam/ Vocational (+2) in Science with Mathematics Stream and applicant passing 3-Year Diploma are eligible to apply B.Sc. ITM Courses.

B.Sc (Hons) Data Science: Applicants must have passed the Higher Secondary (+2) or an equivalent/vocational (+2) examination in Science with Mathematics stream are eligible to apply for B.Sc. (Hons.) Data Science.

9. GENERAL RULES FOR ADMISSION:

- 9.1** Admission to the college is provisional and cannot be claimed as a matter of right and may be refused without assigning any reason thereof. Final decision in matters of admission rests with the principal.
- 9.2** Admission to the U.G. Classes shall be done strictly on merit basis based on the percentage of marks secured in the qualifying examination both for general and reserved categories of applicants.
- 9.3** The admission to U.G. (B.Sc. ITM & B.Sc. (Hons) Data Science) shall be done strictly on merit basis for both general and reserve categories candidates.
- 9.4** Admission on transfer basis for U.G. (B.Sc. ITM & B.Sc. (Hons) Data Science) Courses will not be allowed.

10. RESERVATIONS OF SEATS:

Reservation of seats will be made as per the government guidelines.

11. VACANT RESERVED SEATS:

After admitting all eligible applicants for the reserved categories, the balance of reserved seats, if any, shall be filled up by general candidates. No seat shall remain reserved for any category beyond the last date of normal period of Admission.

- 11.1** Reservation of seats and Weightage of marks for admission to U.G. Classes shall be admissible as per the govt. reservation guidelines of Common Prospectus(CP) of +3 e-Admission-2026-27

12. APPLICATION FORM & PROSPECTUS:

13. HOW TO FILLUP THE OFFLINE APPLICATION FORM :

Interested applicants may download the Application Form from the College Website : www.mpcautocollege.org.in and manually fill the same Application form and follow the above procedure.

13.1 HOW TO SUBMIT THE DOWNLOADED PRINTED APPLICATION FORM (HARD COPY):

After downloading, Print Application form, the applicant has to affix his/her recent colour passport size photograph (self-attested) on the application form. The applicant and his/her parent/guardian have to sign in the Application Form before submitting the same. The filled in application form along with the Bank Draft of Rs.300/- (**For U.G.**) in favour of the Principal, M.P.C.Autonomous College, Takhatpur, Baripada, Payable at **S.B.I. SME Branch, Takhatpur, Code-06934 &** copies of the documents indicated at the end of the Application Form should be submitted **through Registered post/Speed post** so as to reach the Office of the Principal by 05:00 P.M. on or before last date.

13.2 SUBMISSION OF FORMS:

- A) Application Form duly filled in should reach the Principal MPC Autonomous College, Takhatpur, Baripada- 757003 latest by the last date of receipt of forms by Registered post / Speed Post / Drop Box. The Envelope Containing the Filled Application Form for along with Bank Draft and requisite certificates etc. must be superscribed "**Application for UG admission in**(Concerned subjects) for session 2026-27.
- B) **The College shall not be held responsible for any kind of postal delay.** The candidates are, therefore, advised to send their applications sufficiently ahead of time so that they reach the College by 05.00 p.m. of the last date for submission of form.
- C) Applications incomplete in any manner or received after the last date shall not ordinarily be considered for admission.

13.4 DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Original Bank Draft.
- b) Application Form duly filled in and signed by the Candidate and by his/ her father / mother / guardian at the places specified for the purpose.
- c) An unstamped self-addressed envelope of 10 cm × 11 cm size.
- d) Self Attested photocopies of certificate and mark sheet of HSC or equivalent examination.
- e) Self Attested photocopies of Mark sheet and certificate. Of Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.
- f) Attested photocopies of certificates in support of reservation.
- g) Permanent Resident Certificate, if applicable. (attested photocopy)

14. SELECTION FOR ADMISSION

14.1 SELECTION

Admission to the above Courses will be made strictly on the basis of merit based on the mark secured in the last qualifying examination.

14.4 INTIMATION:

The list of selected /wait listed candidates will be notified in the college Notice Board and college website : www.mpcautocollege.org.in or through e-Mail /SMS.

14.5 ADMISSION:

The candidates selected for admission / kept in the waiting list are required to come personally to the college with required documents and fees for admission on the date and time specified on the Intimation Letter / Notice / SMS/College Website

N.B.:-The admission of the candidate kept in the waiting list shall be made strictly on the basis of merit subject to the availability of seats.

14.6 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED/ SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION :

- a) Intimation Letter.
- b) The original mark sheet and certificate of H.S. or equivalent examination for U.G.
- c) The Original High School Certificate and Mark Sheet.
- d) The Original School / College leaving Certificate.
- e) The Original Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- f) The Original and one attested photocopy of Caste Certificate, if applicable.
- g) Original Income Certificate of the parent issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Addl. Tahasildar for S.C. / S.T. / OBC students along with an attested photocopy.
- h) Admission fees in shape of Bank Draft.
- i) The Original Certificate in Support of claim. If any, for reservation / weightage.
- j) The Original Residential Certificate, if applicable.
- k) Four (4) copies of recent **Passport size** photographs.
- l) Original Migration Certificate
- m) One photocopy of each of the above certificates.

Caution:

- a) Certificate not signed by competent authority shall not be considered for selection. Doubtful cases shall be referred to the Crime Branch or other appropriate authorities for scrutiny.
- b) Claim for reservation shall not be considered unless it is supported by genuine documents.

- c) The Selection / admission of a candidate shall be invalidated if suppression of facts, submission of false information or forgery of documents is detected during the process of admission or thereafter, and such cases shall be reported to the Crime Branch for necessary action.

NOTE:

- i) The applicant is required to write "Submitted by me" and put his /her full signature and mention the date on the reverse of all documents submitted along with the application form.
- iii) The photographs must be signed on the front and pasted in places provided.
- iv) The candidate must mention in capital letter at the top right hand corner of application form: SC/ ST/ SEBC/PH/BR/ESM/DP /HOSTEL as applicable to him /her.
- v) No certificate shall be entertained after submission of application form.

15.ADMISSION IN HOSTELS:

- a) Admission in hostels shall be made on the basis of merit as is determined for the admission into college.
- b) The vacancies allotted to different faculties are subject to change depending on the number of applications and eligibility.
- c) A student selected for admission in a hostel shall have to submit an undertaking duly countersigned by parents and local guardian at the time of admission to the effect that he/she shall abide by the rules of the college and hostel and pay the dues in time.
- d) Admission to hostels cannot be claimed as a matter of right and it is subject to availability of seats.

16. ATTENDANCE

(i) **Minimum Requirement:**

No student shall be promoted to next higher class unless he / she attends a minimum of 75% of theory and practical classes and seminars taken separately in each semester. A candidate shall have to give, at the time of admission, an undertaking to the effect that he/ she shall attend required number of classes (75%) in each semester.

(ii) **Condonation:**

The Principal may condone shortage of attendance to the extent of 15% in exceptional cases.

17. INTERPRETATION OF RULES:

In matters of dispute relating to rules and procedures herein, the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding. Rules mentioned in the brochure are subject to change / modification as per University & Govt. orders.
